JOB SUMMARY

Operate Tajima machine to embroider decorative designs on garments by performing the following duties.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Reads work order to determine proper logo and location of embroidery.

Checks with supervisor on all aspects of what each job entails.

Changes needles in Tajima machine and re-threads needle as needed.

Use embroidery hoops to hold fabric tight.

Read ruler to ensure proper positioning of garment in hooping.

Check garments, colors and all programs to be run.

Operate automatic embroidery machines with multiple sewing heads controlled by disk.

Observe Tajima operation to detect defects in stitching that indicate machine malfunction.

Loading and unloading of Tajima machine.

Follow all safety procedures to assure a safe work place.

Other duties may be assigned as directed by Management.
